## Preface





**Prof. Marc Weller**

## Lecturers

Marc Weller is Professor of International Law and International Constitutional Studies in the University of Cambridge and the Director of the Lauterpacht Centre for International Law. Professor Weller holds Masters degrees from the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy and the University of Cambridge, and Doctorates in Law, in Economic and Social Sciences, and in International Law from the Universities of Frankfurt, Hamburg and Cambridge respectively. Professor Weller has been trained in complex negotiations at Harvard Law School and the John F. Kennedy School of Government and has extensive experience in international high-level, high-stakes negotiations. He is a fully qualified and accredited mediator and a member of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. He is the author, editor or co-editor of some 25 books and a large number of academic journal articles and book chapters.



**Prof. Bimal N. Patel**

Dr Bimal N. Patel is Director and Professor of Public International Law of Gujarat National Law University, India. He obtained his PhD in International Law from Leiden University (State Practice of India and Development of International Law) and PhD in International Law and Governance from Jaipur National University, India (Responsibility of International Organisations).

Professor Patel teaches courses and supervises thesis and seminar papers in Public International Law, Peaceful Settlement of International Disputes and Law of the Sea and Maritime Law. Professor Patel possesses more than 20 years teaching and research experience various areas in international law. He has extensively studied and published the jurisprudence of the international tribunals including ICJ, ITLOS, etc. He has published, edited several books, research papers/articles/surveys in leading academic and international law journals. He has been involved in drafting several national and state primary and secondary legislations, regulations, rules and given lectures at various universities across the world.



**Prof. Robert D. Sloane**


Robert David Sloane is Professor of Law and R. Gordon Butler Scholar in International Law at Boston University. He received his B.A., magna cum laude, with Departmental Honors in Philosophy, from Columbia University, his J.D. from Yale Law School, and a Diploma from The Hague Academy of International Law. His scholarship focuses on public international law, national security and foreign relations law, international criminal law, the law of war, international human rights, and jurisprudence, and he has published two books and more than 40 articles and shorter works in these fields. In 2007 and 2009, he received the Lieber Prize for outstanding scholarship in the law of war by an author under 35 years of age; and in 2013, the Francis Deák Prize for meritorious scholarship published in the American Journal of International Law by a younger author. Professor Sloane has been a visiting professor at Harvard, Yale, Michigan, and the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy.



**Prof. Carlos Espluges**

*Carlos Espluges Mota, LLM (Harvard'85), MSc (Edinburgh'83), PhD (Valencia'83), is since 1997 full Professor of Private international Law at the University of Valencia (Spain). He is a leading Spanish Scholar on Private International Law and International Trade Law. He has written more than 400 works (books, book's chapters and articles in Spain and abroad) and he has been invited to lecture in many universities in Europe, America and Asia. He is President of the Spanish Association of Professors of International Law and International Relations since 2013. Additionally, Prof. Espluges is Member of several legislative commissions, and he acts as International Arbitrator and Mediator.*

**Prof. Paul Dempsey**

*Paul Stephen Dempsey is Tomlinson Professor of Global Governance in Air & Space Law and Director of the Institute of Air & Space Law at McGill University, in Montreal, Canada. For more than two decades, he held the chair as Professor of Transportation Law, and was Director of the Transportation Law Program at the University of Denver.*

*Dr. Dempsey holds the following degrees: Bachelor of Arts, Juris Doctor, University of Georgia; Master of Laws, George Washington University; Doctor of Civil Laws, McGill University.*

*He currently serves on the Editorial Board of the German Journal of Air & Space Law, and is Editor-in-Chief of the Annals of Air & Space Law. He is President of the International Air & Space Law Academy, and vice-Chair of the Aviation Section of the Transportation Lawyers Association. Professor Dempsey has published more than two dozen books, 100 law review and academic journal articles, and scores of newspaper and news magazine editorials.*



**Prof. Junji Nakagawa**

*Junji Nakagawa is professor of international economic law at the Institute of Social Science, University of Tokyo. Born in Hiroshima in 1955, he got his B.A., M.A. and Ph. D. in law from University of Tokyo. He was associate professor at the Tokyo Institute of Technology (1990 to 1995), and at the Institute of Social Science, University of Tokyo (1995-2000) before assuming his current position. He was a visiting scholar at Georgetown University Law Center, Harvard Law School, and at El Colegio de México. He also taught at Graduate School of International Studies at University of Denver, Fletcher School at Tufts University, and at Free University of Berlin. He is a member of the Executive Council of the Society of International Economic Law. Among his publication are *Legal Process of Nationalization Conflicts in Natural Resources Sector* (Kokusai Shoin, 1990), *International Economic Law* (Yuhikaku, 2003), *International Harmonization of Economic Regulation* (Oxford University Press, 2011), and *WTO: Beyond Trade Liberalization* (Iwanami Shoten, 2013).*

# Admission



## General Information

1. The closing date of the application for admission is 30 April 2016.
2. Applicants to the Xiamen Academy should be:
  - (1) law students; or
  - (2) teachers, lawyers or officials, etc. with at least a bachelor degree; and
  - (3) fluent in English.
3. The admission office of Xiamen Academy retains the right to require applicants to supply related documents or certificates to show their qualification or competency.
4. Admissions are granted on a basis of academic criteria and first-come-first-served basis. All applicants are required to fill out the registration form (*available on the Academy's website*) clearly and completely, with accurate and truthful information.

## Other Information

1. Visa Application: attendees shall bear the costs for obtaining a China entry visa. Xiamen Academy may provide necessary assistance to facilitate the attendees' visa application.
2. If applicants would like to apply for scholarship, please make clear the type of scholarship you intend to apply in the application documents.
3. Attendees are responsible for their accommodation in Xiamen. If possible, Xiamen Academy will provide relevant information.
4. If there is anything unclear, please feel free to contact us.



## Application Documents Checklist

Checklist of the application documents (*can be submitted either by regular mail or via email*):

1. A registration form;
2. Two letters of recommendation from two professors of international law (*in a sealed envelope, signed on the reverse; or sent by the referee directly to the Academy if via email*);
3. A curriculum vitae;
4. A certified copy of your examination certificates or list of the courses that you have followed in international law (*private and public*), with the number of hours and your results, issued by your university (*or scanned copy if sent via email*). If this is not possible, draw up by yourself and certify on your honour; and
5. An application for scholarship and supporting documents (*in scanned copy if sent via email*), if applicable.

## Registration Fee



### Registration fee for 2016 Summer Programme (3 weeks)

For Chinese attendees, including attendees from Chinese Mainland, Hong Kong SAR, Macau SAR and Chinese Taipei:

- (1) University Students: RMB 1,000; or
- (2) University Teachers: RMB 2,000; or
- (3) Others: RMB 3,000.

For Non-Chinese attendees: USD 600.

*\* Please note that the registration fee covers test fee and course materials, but does not cover any other expenses including but not limited to accommodation, transport, etc.*

# Scholarship



## Types and Eligibility for Scholarships

1. Subject to the Regulations for Obtaining Scholarships, Xiamen Academy provides limited number of scholarships to qualified applicants on a selective basis.
2. Xiamen Academy offers two types of scholarships:
  - 2.1. A-type scholarship includes:
    - (1) Full exemption of the registration fee;
    - (2) A certain sum of subsidy for the trip to and from the recipient's city to Xiamen:
      - a. USD 400 for recipients from Asian countries (excluding recipients from China), or
      - b. USD 600 for recipients from non-Asian countries, or
      - c. Full reimbursement to round-trip hard-seat train tickets for recipients from Mainland China, or
      - d. Reimbursement to travel expenses up to USD 200 for recipients from Hong Kong SAR, Macau SAR and Chinese Taipei.
  - 2.2. B-type scholarship includes full exemption of the registration fee.
3. The scholarships will be awarded to the recipients during the period of summer programme. However, failure to finish the programme or unexcused absenteeism from the course will result in the forfeiture of the scholarship in full, requiring a full refund of the scholarship by the disqualified recipient.



4. Scholarships are granted on the considerations of academic performance, financial status of applicants and the country of origin, among other factors.
5. Application for scholarship shall be submitted in a separate typewritten document indicating the type of scholarship, together with supporting documents.

# Scholarship Regulations

## Regulations for Obtaining Scholarships

### Article 1

*Each year, Xiamen Academy makes available a programme of scholarships which are awarded on the considerations of academic performance, financial status and the types of country of origin, among other factors.*

### Article 2

*Recipients of scholarship must undertake to comply strictly with the provisions of these regulations concerning their obligations, in the event their application is accepted by the Curatorium. None of the documents supplied by candidates in support of a scholarship application will be returned. As a result, university certificates must be provided in the form of certified copies.*

### Article 3

*Application for scholarship must be typewritten and accompanied by supporting documents, and must be received by the Secretariat, not later than 30 April 2016.*

### Article 4

*The Curatorium examines all applications received before the deadline. It establishes a list of the recipients of scholarship; and it is in no way bound by any recommendation that it receives.*

### Article 5

*The Curatorium's decisions will be notified to the persons concerned during the month of May.*

### Article 6

*The amount of the scholarship is paid by the Academy to each recipient during the period of summer programme.*

### Article 7

*Recipients of scholarship must attend the Academy's courses throughout the session.*

### Article 8

*Any failure by a scholarship recipient to comply with the obligations laid down by these regulations will result in the withdrawal of the scholarship; moreover, the Academy reserves the right to demand the reimbursement of sums already paid to the recipient.*
